
! <u>Click here for video link.</u> *Actions*:

5 fingers for the 5 snowmen, put hands up as if putting on a crown for the hat line, stretch arms up above your head and bring them down with twinkling fingers out to the sides for when the sun comes out, and get your body lower when you melt away... the more dramatic the better!

Go for a Winter walk! It is important to get some fresh air when we can. If you do go on a walk, bring your Winter checklist with you! Talk about what you can see around you, the trees, animals, clouds, weather — any frosty leaves? What sounds do you hear. Are any of these on our Winter list? Check them off! You might need to go on a few walks to find all these winter signs.



Help Miss Kelly recall what happened on Shelley's walk and in which order she met her animals friends the duck, dog, cat and robin! We are **learning** about first and last. Click here for video link



Collect some white items and put them into an opaque bag. Mix it around- now it is is a freely bag! Without looking- put your hand inside and have a feel around can you guess what the white items are? What do they feel like? What shape are they? When you take them out, can you put them in order of size?

Do all your toys know what Winter is like? Try taking them outside and telling your toy what you can see and feel that tell us it is Winter. Ask an adult to help you take a picture or video of your toy's favourite bit of the walk, or draw a picture of the part of Winter they saw or heard about that they like the most. It will be just like Shelley's first Winter walk!
