What you'll need:

- Paper plate
- Red paint
- Paint brush
- Black marker
- Yellow paper
- Scissors



How to make your Firefighter Hat



1. Paint the paper plate red.

2. Cut the paper plate as shown.



3. Trim the edges so the cut part resembles a firefighter hat as shown.



4. Cut a small shield from the yellow paper.



5. Write a number on the shield with the black marker. Stick the shield on the hat as shown.

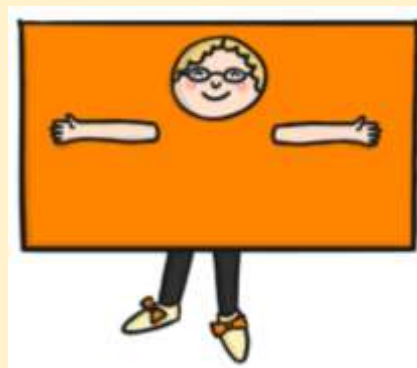
Our new colour of the month is **GREEN!** Go on a colour hunt! What can you find.....??
