We have another very busy month ahead of us in the Nursery as we have lots to celebrate in March! We will be celebrating special occasions such as World Book Day, St. Patrick's Day and of course, Mother's Day.

Learning in the Nursery

We will be learning about <u>Spring and the Farm</u>. Our learning will include:

- Finding out about new life in spring.
- Learning about farm animals and the sounds they make
- Matching baby animals to their mothers
- Talking about life on a farm on a daily basis
- Counting eggs and chicks etc./ ordering for size
- Celebrating special occasions such as World Book Day, St. Patrick's Day and Mother's Day.
- Going on a Spring walk and making a collection of Spring items

The children have been learning to recognise their name in Nursery. This learning will be on-going. We are developing mark-making/ early writing in the nursery daily. This is an important skill to develop especially in preparation for P1. Some ideas to develop this skill at home include: using chalk outside on patio, painting with water and large paintbrushes, making marks in sand, using markers and whiteboards, pretending to write on each other's back e.g. guess the shape etc.
