Home Learning

We will be learning about <u>Minibeasts, Frogs and Seeds</u>. Our learning will include:

- Recognising and naming all the creepy crawlies we find
- Exploring outside for with magnifying glasses for bugs
- Opportunities to discuss emotions and behaviours by reading stories such as 'The Bad Tempered Ladybird', The Very Greedy Bee', 'The Very Busy Spider',' The Very Ugly Bug', 'The Very Friendly Firefly' etc
- Caring for living things-plants and animals

 As well as:
- Lots and lots of counting and recognising numbers
- Ordering and sequencing for size and using language associated with size
- Identifying patterns and copying patterns (looking for patterns in magazines or at home -wallpaper, socks, duvets, clothes etc)
- Talking about similarities and differences in objects
- Exploring stories in detail by looking at sequencing main parts, discussing characters and making predictions.
